I would like to offer my highest possible personal recommendation to Shea Elizabeth Lisak for an instructor position [REDACTED]


Ms. Lisak completed her Private Pilot Certificate (ASEL) prior to her Freshman year at Arizona State University (ASU) where she majors in Aeronautical Management Technology. She has been on the Dean's List since starting ASU in Fall 2022 and has a cumulative GPA of 3.91.

In the short 2.5yrs of attending ASU, she has completed a Commercial Pilot Certification (ASEL & AMEL) with Instrument Ratings, gained High Performance & Complex Endorsements, and earned CFI, CFII, and MEI FAA Certifications. She is currently Restricted ATP Eligible at 1000 hours.

In her 'free time', she serves as ASU's lead Aviation Tutor and is the main contact point between the head of the Aviation Department and all ASU Aviation Tutors. Ms. Lisak also volunteers for the US Civil Air Patrol, where she assists in search and rescue efforts. She has been formally credited with a 'Find Ribbon' awarded to CAP members for making a find (distress or non-distress) on a search and rescue mission. Ms. Lisak personally assisted in a definite search objective assigned to her Ground Team and then located, positively identified, and personally silenced an ELT.

I can think of no person more worthy of a Flight Instructor position than Ms. Lisak. I am a 40+ year retiree of the US Navy and Marine Corps and retired at the rank of CAPTAIN (O6).
